Supplies:

***Basic Sewing Supplies**

Simply Swoon by Thimble Blossoms available at Fabric City

Fabric for Baby Quilt

Thread to piece top - Signature

Machine needles Microtex Sharp 12

Full bobbin

Sewing machine in good working order (cleaned, oiled, new needle)

1/4" foot

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler(s) – 6.5"x12.5" & and medium size mat

18"x 24"

Optional: 3 1/2"x12 1/2" trim up ruler & Bloc-Loc 6 1/2" square up ruler

Follow the cutting instructions for baby quilt and label each piece as you cut. Practice a 1/4" seam by sewing two 1.5" x 5" strips of fabric together. The width after piecing should be 2.5". If the seam is too wide or too narrow, adjust your needle position. Bring your sewing machine manual if you're unsure how to adjust the needle position.
