Small acrylic ruler (6" x 6" and 12" x 12" works well)

Iron and small pressing mat

Thin Pressing cloth

A heavy flat item to keep your cards flat. An old Textbook works great.

Applique pressing sheet

No Sewing Machine Needed!!! This project will be completed in class, and you will get a copy of the instructions to make more at home.
