Supplies:

***Basic Sewing Supplies**

Singular Stars by Judy Martin

Fabric for Portland Lone Star Page 113 in book

Alpha/numerical pins or clips with alpha/numerical stickers

1/4" presser foot

Cutting station: 18x24" mat, 45mm rotary cutter with new blade, 12" and 24" rulers, minimum 12" square, 6" ruler and small square ruler

Ironing station: iron, pressing mat, and clapper

11 or 12 sized sharp needles

ruler arrows (optional, but worth it)

Patchwork or flathead pins

Pick up a worksheet prior to class so that you can label your fabric. Read pages 4-18, have fabric pre-washed if that is your routine.

Spray with Best Press so that it stabilizes your angles: you may have to do several layers of the spray, pressing in-between each layer. Do not cut your fabric. Test your 1/4" seam following page 10 and note any changes you need to get the 1/4" required.
