Batting - 18-20" Square of 100% cotton, 70/30, or 80/20

Thread – Bring 2-3 different dark colored threads you use regularly for quilting.

Bobbins

Sewing machine in good working order (cleaned, oiled, new needle, spool covers)

Machine needles – Topstitch 14 or Machine Quilting 11 & 14 Regular Foot, 1/4" Foot, Walking Foot (including quilting bar), Open Toe Foot, Darning Foot (Free-motion foot), Stitch in the Ditch Foot (if you have it)

Marking Pen, Small Permanent Marker for writing

Optional: Sewer's Aid

Quilters Gloves

Machine extension table

3 ½"x 12 ½" Creative Grids Trim Up Ruler

Press and layer fabric & batting
