Let's have some fun making a garment with our serger and coverstitch machines while learning the techniques that go into making a pullover top. Techniques we will be using are: edge serging, seams, and hems along with corners, curves and gathering.

Supplies:

*Basic Sewing Supplies The Coverstitch Technique Manual Big Book of Serging by Bernina Sewing Your Perfect Capsule Wardrobe (pattern is in this book) Machine/machines in good working order and all your presser feet fabric and notions needed for pattern Sewing tools needed: scissors, marking tools, needles, pins, clips Tracing pattern cloth: roll or 3 yrds and 12-24" straight ruler. 28 mm rotary cutter and mat, all optional

First evening we will touch on some different seams and hems. Fit and cut out our pattern. Second day we will finish our garment and work on some other techniques throughout the day.

Don't have a coverstitch? Bring your sewing machine. LIMIT TO 6 PEOPLE. Prewash and press fabric.
